Individuals received food from our network of food pantries. Other services rendered are as follows:

- 58,650 Households received toiletries.
- 265 Households received emergency rental assistance which avoided eviction.
- 187 Households received rental assistance.

Is to provide low-income residents of Clay, Jackson, and Platte counties in Missouri comprehensive support services to help them become self-sufficient.

Healthy Homes

Individuals experienced the benefits of the Healthy Homes program for a total of 64 households served. A total of 88 home repairs and 23 energy efficients improvements were made to improve the health and safety of the occupants in the home. **62** seniors and persons with disabilities were helped.

Weatherization

Individuals benefited from our Weatherization program. Here's the breakdown:

- 261 Energy Audits performed
- 438 Repairs Completed

- 462 Energy Efficiency Improvements
- 252 Homes Completed



Youth Services

- 102 Youth received clothing assistance
- 44 Youth attended the summer enrichment program
- 24 High School students participated in PAVE receiving \$10,500 in stipends
- 16 High School seniors awarded more than \$38K in scholarships
- \$37,500 spent on Occupational Skills Training
